Human milk has a high economic value. For example, feeding it to preterm infants reduces the incidence and/or severity of prematurity-

related illnesses, which indirectly reduces hospital costs, as shown below. In addition, the increased own mother's milk volumes that PersonalFit™ PLUS with Symphony® contribute to help reduce hospital reliance on donor milk and formula, which can also cut costs.
